THE GARDENER'S DIARY With Martin Fish

It's time to get your secateurs out and give rose bushes and climbing roses an autumn prune to reduce their height. Prune bushes back by around half and with climbers shorten some of the long stems to prevent them blowing around in the wind.

As leaves start to fall thick and fast from the trees, gather them up on a regular basis, especially from the lawn and mix them with other garden waste into your compost bin.

If you are storing fruit and veg in a shed, such as potatoes, marrows apples and pears, check them regularly to make sure they are not starting to rot.

November is the traditional time to plant tulip bulbs now that the soil is starting to cool down and remember to plant three times the depth of the bulb.

Make sure tender plants such as pelargoniums, fuchsias and shrubby salvias growing in pots are brought into a light frost-free place to protect them over winter.


As you finish clearing areas of the veg garden either fork it over lightly or spread garden compost over the area for the worms to pull down.

There is still time to plant garlic directly into the garden or start the individual cloves off in small pots of compost and stand them outside in a cold frame to produce plants ready for spring planting.
