
EMPTY CARTIDGES - COLLECTION BOX IN THE HALL PORCH

PARISH COUNCIL NEWS - JULY

Thank you to those parishioners who attended the Annual Parish Assembly on the 9th May. The Council is taking forward the issues raised on your behalf, and in the meantime there is an opportunity for you to voice your own concerns about the discontinuation of the No 70 bus service (see below).

Fell Bridge Repairs

North Yorkshire Highways Dept has apologised for the time it is taking for the bridge to be repaired; the Drainage Board want the new culvert to have a sufficient flow rate to cope with significant rain events, but they also have to take into account the live gas mains pipe, which has made the design quite complex. Following a number of onsite meetings, the design is finally close to being signed off by both the Drainage Board and the Northern Gas Engineers. By the middle of July, Highways should be in a position to agree a start date with their contractors.

The situation has been incredibly frustrating for everyone affected, but there is a genuine risk of the road collapsing, so please bear in mind that if you do ignore the road closure signs, your insurance would not cover you in the event of an accident.

Public Transport

North Yorkshire Council has acknowledged that public transport emerged as a top priority for residents during its 'Let's Talk' consultations with residents last year. It is going to draft a new Local Transport Plan for the County, so please, please take part in their latest survey, which is open to everyone, including youngsters: Have Your Say Today - Survey - Let's Talk Transport - Let's Talk North Yorkshire (commonplace.is)
